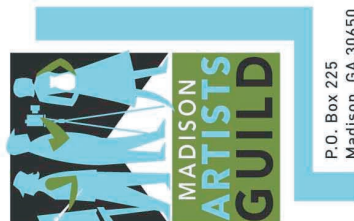

# TOWN 220

A regional call for entries for the juried show of **Large Works** which will be rotated four times annually in the **Gallery at Town 220** located in historic downtown Madison, Georgia. This is the second annual **XLG SHOW**.

The juror is **Corrine Colarusso**, expressionist landscape painter from Atlanta. She is the recipient of myriad prestigious grants, fellowships & awards. Colarusso is an accomplished painter of large scale works.

Entry is open to all 2-D artists working large. All media will be considered but works must not exceed 200 lbs. or 13' x 10' x 12" max. See brochure for details and entry form.

Compete for an opportunity to be one of four featured artists in the Madison Artists Guild's XLG SHOW @ TOWN 220, a quarterly exhibit in the Gallery at Town 220 in downtown Madison Georgia. A historic town featured in Atlanta Magazine as one of the best. This regional call for entries is a chance to be chosen for a solo show of your original large works.

JUROR, Corrine Colarusso & MAG Co-Curators Liselott Johnsson, Karen Strelecki, & Janet Mason will select 4 artists whose work will be featured in one of 4 quarterly shows in 2012, lasting 3 months each. All quarterly show openings will feature a wine reception and possibly an artist talk by the featured artist. MAG promotes this show extensively through its website, blog, print and social networking media as well as on-air radio spots.

Corrine Colarusso is a highly respected Atlanta artist; a painter of large and enchanting works representing the feeling of the natural world. A recipient of a National Endowment for the Arts Grant, Colarusso also received a Fulbright-Hayes Research & Travel Grant to India & Nepal. She was chosen as a visiting artist at the Academy of Rome, the Cortona Program of the University of Georgia, & The Ossabaw Island Project. ## Rules of the Show

All media are eligible but size must not exceed 13' x 10' x 12", maximum weight is 200 lbs.

All work must be original and not executed as student work. No prints, unless photographic prints or as part of a collaged piece.

All work must be wired with appropriate tensile strength wire, strap hangers or other secure hanging device. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS!

This is an artist curated show including the layout & hanging of the work. Selected works must be hand delivered and installed by the artist.

The Town 220 Gallery is quite large and is an excellent venue for large works. See photos at [www.madisonartistsguild.org](http://www.madisonartistsguild.org) or visit in person to prepare for the show.

All sales will be handled by MAG and 30% commission will be paid to MAG out of all sales. Checks to artists for artwork sold will be paid within 10 days of close of exhibit. All work must remain in place for the duration of the quarterly exhibits. This entry form may be reproduced for further distribution to any artists interested in entering this competition. Questions?
